Welcome and brief introductions

Sister Michele Fisher began by welcoming Sister Anita Quigley, our newly elected Delaware Valley Member Area Coordinator, who along with Sr. Michele, will support our NRVC members and activities in our Delaware Valley Area. Following this introduction, members invited each other to introduce themselves. We were happy to welcome new members, Sisters Anna Marie Phuong Nguyen, RA, Cecilia Nanni Costa, FMIJ, Sr. Liz Sjoberg, DC, Sr. Maria Zepeda, MSBT and Sr. Sherly "Sunny" Padayattil, FSSE. For a brief minute, Srs. Shannon Hoffman, SC and Sr. Luciana D' Cruze, MPF had signed on the meeting, but seemed to have lost the connection. We hope they'll be able to sign on for our next meeting and look forward to their presence with us.

Opening Prayer:

Sr. Michele Fisher shared a power-point Prayer for the Synod (attached) that included a song composed by Sr. Santrina, IBVM and produced by the Pauline Sisters in Africa. The words after the song were taken from Pope Francis' homily for the opening of the 2024 Synod on Synodality.

NRVC Updates

Sr. Michele noted that the NRVC National Office, after bidding a fond farewell to Marge Argyelan for her nine years of service as our Director of Database Administration, now welcomes Sister Kathleen Branham, OSF to the NRVC Staff as the new Director of Database Administration.

• On the local level, we welcomed Sr. Anita Quigley, SHCJ, as our Delaware Valley Member Area Coordinator after being elected by our members at our June meeting. Her first term began July 1, 2024.

• Mrs. Nancy Costello shared some NRVC Board updates and noted that this past September the Board met here in Pennsylvania at the Rafaela Retreat Center in Haverford. It was extra special as this was Nancy's final meeting with the Board as she has completed her one term of office (3 years). We are grateful for Nancy's excellent service on behalf of NRVC and look forward to her continued presence with us here in the Delaware Valley Member Area.

Convocation 2024

- Sr. Michele reported that we have reached the 200 mark for participants in Convocation 2024. NRVC strongly encouraged members of leadership teams, formation ministers, communications and mission advancement members to join with fellow vocation ministers for a shared experience of walking humbly and learning together. - The NRVC Board Intercultural Committee is preparing an *Ofrenda* to honor the celebration of El Dia De Los Muertos (November 2). Participants in Convocation are asked to bring photos or other mementos of their deceased loved ones (make sure your name is on each of the items) for the Ofrenda.
- We invited those members who are registered to attend Convocation to consider getting together as a Member Area to share a meal and conversation. After discussion, the group that was present voted to gather for dinner on Friday, November 1. We will gather after the afternoon prayer (remain in the room after everyone else exits) to decide where we would like to go. To help keep things simple, kindly bring cash rather than credit cards for this meal. In addition to going out to one of the local restaurants, given our various dietary needs/restrictions and likes, we may have the option of ordering in and finding a more conducive space to meet and share at the hotel. Whatever we decide to do, it will be great to have a chance to be together in person!
- It was suggested that since there is no hotel shuttle from the airport, people may want to meet up at the airport to share transportation. To facilitate this, we ask those going to Convocation to share your flight arrangements with Sister Anita Quigley (aquigley@shcj.org) who will try to organize and create a list of similar arrival and departure times. Please include your cell phone numbers for easy contact.
- **NOTE**: A question was raised about our Convocations being held either during or right before National Vocation Awareness Week when many events are planned. Vocation ministers, if attending Convocation, miss out on invitations or opportunities that are specially planned for NVAW. Can the timing of Convocation be re-considered when planning for Convocation 2026?
- Invitation from Sr. Debbie Borneman for Delaware Valley Member Area to host a 2-day workshop in Fall 2025.
- Sister Debbie Borneman, NRVC Director of Mission Integration, reached out to Sr. Michele Fisher, Member Area Coordinator, to explore the possibility of the Delaware Valley Member

Area hosting a two-day NRVC workshop sometime in Fall 2025. After discussion, there was an excitement and openness among the members to hosting such an event in our area. Members began brainstorming possible venues including San Rafaela Retreat Center, Haverford, Malvern Retreat Center, Malvern, the IHM Spirituality Center in Immaculata, PA, The Mother Boniface Center (MSBT Sisters) in northeast Philadelphia, The Norbertine Center at Daylesford Abbey and the Filippini Sisters Retreat Center in Mantoloking, NJ.

Sister Michele Fisher will reach out to Sister Debbie for further information including possible
dates, number of participants, needs for technology and other details we can share with our
retreat centers. Members have already begun contacting the various retreat centers to look for
openings for Fall 2025 (September thru November), weekend and mid-week openings. Sr.
Michele will contact the group once more details become available and we will follow up with
a report at Convocation and at our December meeting.

• Financial Report

- Sister Michele Fisher reported that a \$500 donation from our Member Area was given to NRVC for a Convocation Sponsorship. This was agreed upon at our June meeting and then arranged through Mrs. Maureen Cetera at the National Office
- At present, the Delaware Valley Member Area has a balance of \$ 3,486.82 in our NRVC account.
- There have been some questions about collecting dues from the Area member congregations for our ongoing needs. We have not collected dues in the past two years as we were still coming out of COVID and were not having in-person meetings or events. We will add this discussion to our December meeting agenda.
