NRVC Updates

• Feedback from participants who attended Convocation 2024

There were seven members present who attended Convocation 2024 in Minneapolis. Their comments were very positive and included the opportunity to network with others, the spirit of communion and community that was palpable, the very personal signs of welcome and hospitality (choosing lanyards, interaction with members of NRVC Staff), the beautifully prepared and well celebrated liturgies, the powerful symbolism of the *ofrenda* table and banners as the centerpiece of the liturgies and conferences, the quality of the speakers and their powerful and challenging and inviting messages, the opportunity for new and first-time members to be given a good framework and lots of excellent information, the time of simply being together with others who have a passion for religious life, a chance to honor each one's personal vocation and story as well as learn more about the people we minister to. Overall, it was a wonderful experience and we look forward to Convocation 2026!

• Updates from Sr. Debbie Borneman, NRVC Director of Mission Integration

We were very fortunate to have Sr. Debbie present with us for our entire meeting. Sr Debbie reminded those who attended Convocation to be sure to complete the evaluation forms. Links for the form can be found on the NRVC website. It is important to put your name on the form so that Sr. Debbie can address any specific concerns with you or be able to clarify comments or ideas.

Sr. Debbie commented on three areas from the convocation that had raised some common concerns/comments.

- a. **Meals at Convocation** Some attendees asked that a light breakfast be included in the Convocation package. Sr. Debbie shared that each meal costs \$60 per person. In trying to keep Convocation prices affordable to as many members as possible, the choice to serve only one meal per day was made. From the hotel, there was easy access to local restaurants and grocery stores for participants to purchase what they needed.
- b. **Convocation Banquet** In a spirit of "Walking Humbly Together," a meatless, vegetarian entrée was planned, however, the presentation of the main course left questions in some participants' minds that something was missing. It was a good exercise in perspective.
- c. **Supporting our Brother Priests** The presence of so many religious priests at Convocation was edifying. The participation and procession of the priests at all the liturgies was in line with the Feast Days being celebrated as well as a testimony of their commitment not only to their priesthood, but to religious life and to the service of vocations in the Church. We were grateful that so many of our brother religious priests and two bishops chose to be present for Convocation.

Nominations for new NRVC Board Members are now being accepted. Sr. Debbie acknowledged the presence of several past NRVC Board members who were present at the meeting and encouraged members to consider Board service or to nominate someone they believe would be a good candidate for Board membership. Information about the Board and nomination forms are available on the NRVC website. Each NRVC member may submit one recommendation for the Board.

At its spring meeting, the National Board selects new members for a three-year term from the recommendations. The Board seeks to bring skills and experience to the Board to help ensure a balance of gender, geographical, and cultural representation and to image the breadth and diversity of religious consecration in the Church through its new appointments.

The National Board will meet April 9-13, 2025 in Mesilla Park, NM. It will begin planning for Convocation 2026. If any member has thoughts about possible themes or speakers, please contact any of the Board members.

o Financial Report

Sister Michele Fisher reported that a \$500 donation from our Member Area was given to NRVC for a Convocation Sponsorship. This was agreed upon at our June meeting and then arranged through Mrs. Maureen Cetera at the National Office
