- 2. <u>2024 Convocation</u>: The theme of the convocation is, "Walking Humbly Together". It will be held on October 31- November 4 in Minneapolis, MN. Sr. Maria asked the participants how many of them were planning to attend. Three of the participants were planning to attend and two were waiting to make the decision due to some scheduling conflict.

- Bro. Edward Shields, FSC suggested that the topic on Migration in line on Vocation Ministry could be expanded to Inculturality since the reality of religious / consecrated life in community is very diverse and complex.
- Sr. Celia Deutsch, NDS suggested to look at Inculturality in light of Community living and other components of religious / consecrated life that are interrelated to Migration.
